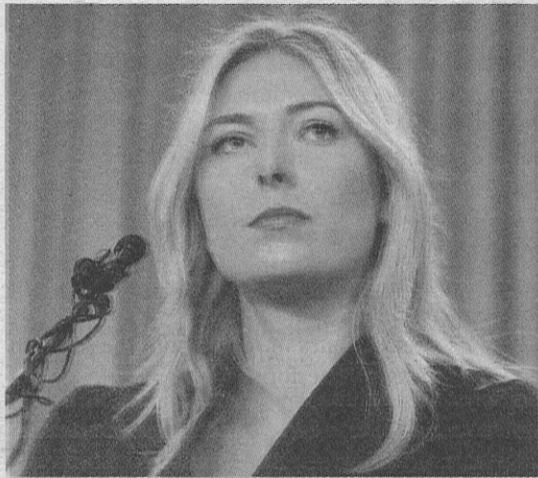


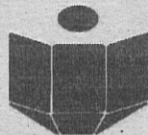

PARIS: Twice former champion Maria Sharapova was surprisingly snubbed by French Open organisers, who opted against handing the Russian a wildcard into this month's claycourt grand slam yesterday. The 30-year-old, who returned from a 15-month doping ban last month, had been expected to be fast-tracked into the qualifying competition for a tournament already without a host of leading players including Serena Williams. The objects of the meeting as set out in the Requisition are as follows:

- b. To resolve that having regard to the importance and public interest in the matters to be debated members of the media be allowed to observe and report on the meeting;
- c. To resolve that the LATT do express its loss of confidence in the Honourable Chief Justice Ivor Archie as Chief Justice of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago;
- d. To resolve that the LATT do express its loss of confidence in the Honourable Chief Justice Ivor Archie as Chairman of the Judicial and Legal Services Commission (JLSC);
- e. To resolve that LATT do express its loss of confidence in Justice Roger Hamel-Smith, Ms. Marjori Thorpe and Justice Humphrey Stollmeyer as members of the JLSC;
- f. To resolve that LATT do call upon the Chief Justice Ivor Archie to resign forthwith as Chief Justice of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago;
- g. To resolve that LATT do call upon Justice Roger Hamel-Smith, Ms. Marjori Thorpe and Justice Humphrey Stollmeyer to resign as members of the JLSC.
