
Seecharan and Ms. Urmilla Seenath be authorised to run the affairs of the FLA until such time as a General Meeting is held to elect the FLA's Committee and Officers.

- c. That the FLA's initial annual membership fees for members under 10 years standing was fixed at \$300.00 and over 10 years standing fixed at \$500.00.
- d. That the FLA's Logo as presented be accepted.

Membership applications will be accepted at the conclusion of the General Meeting. Membership fees will also be accepted in cash only since Clause 12.1 of the Draft Constitution provides for the opening of a bank account by the First Committee [i.e. that there will no bank account into which cheques can be deposited at the time of the General Meeting].
