

# 20 graduate from Sweet Tassa

ON January 13; NGC Trinidad and Tobago Sweet Tassa hosted a graduation ceremony for 20 students of its year-long academy at Mt Stewart Village, Princes Town.

The programme kicked off in Q1 2017 and involved two-hour classes every week. Students were exposed to the musical genres of calypso, nagara, dingolay and chutney, as well as a history of the tassa art fo<del>n</del>n.

Lennifa N Kumar, assistant manager of the tassa group, noted the benefits of the academy included developing the minds of the students musically and teaching them the art form and the culture of tassa drumning. the band's management in coordinating the academy, Lennita responded:

We were able to collaborate with those outside of the band as we incorporated persons who are not drummers but for example, teachers and parents who played an integral part of assisting in the growth of the academy and the students.

## CLOSING DATE FOR NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES AT THE 32nd ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 2018

- The Closing Date for Nomination of Candidates for election of Officers and Members of Council is Friday 23rd February, 2018 at 4:00pm.
- The 32nd Annual General Meeting of the Law Association of Trinidad and Tobago will be held on Friday 23rd March, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. in the Convocation Hall, Hall of Justice, Knox Street, Port-of-Spain (other venues to be announced, if any).
- Nominations for the position of President, Vice President, Treasurer and fifteen (15) Ordinary Members (10 seniors and 5 juniors) must be made in writing on the prescribed Nomination Form. A separate nomination form is required for each position to be contested.
- Nomination Forms can be obtained from the Office of the Law Association located at 2nd Floor 95-97 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and can be downloaded from the Law Association of Trinidad and Tobago's website http://www.lawassociationtt.com.
- Pursuant to paragraph 9(2) of Part II of the Legal Profession Act 1986 only practitioner members who pay their annual subscription to the Law Association are eligible: - (a) to nominate candidates (b) to attend and vote at a general meeting or at an election of members of the Council: and (c) to be elected to the Council.
- Every nomination form of a candidate for election to the Association and the Council shall be signed by not less than five practitioner members and endorsed by the candidate.
